Johnson O'Malley Student Eligibility Form

Students may be eligible for JOM benefits if either the student possesses at least one-fourth degree Indian blood, is an enrolled member of a Federally recognized Tribe, or has a link to a Tribal member (through descendancy) that is within a certain proximity, meaning the student has a least one parent or grandparent (living or deceased) who is a member of a federally recognized Tribe. In addition, BIE interprets 25 CFR 273.112 to also permit blood quantum calculations that include blood from different federally recognized Tribes to ensure an inclusive interpretation of the JOM eligibility criteria.
